The two memorials on the front wall of the church were originally from the Methodist Chapel in the village.

	<p>Memorial to Thomas Blamey died 1898 Memorial to William Symons died 1925</p>
	<p>Font, octagonal freestone font on a square base. 2 carved heads to the bowl suggest an early date but the tooling is late 19th Century</p>
	<p>Tapestry Picture of a fishing scene by John Craske (1881-1943). Born in Norfolk, John Craske took up what he called "painting in wools" in 1928. He used padding stitches to simulate textures such as waves and skies.</p>
