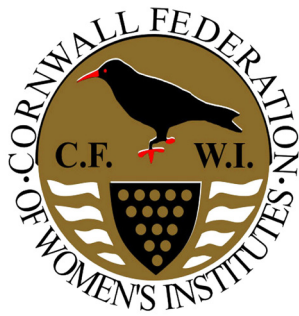

## Veryan WI

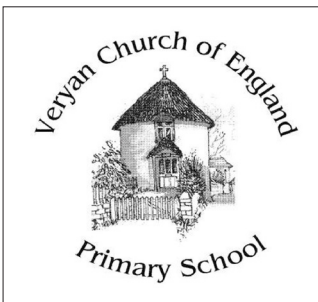

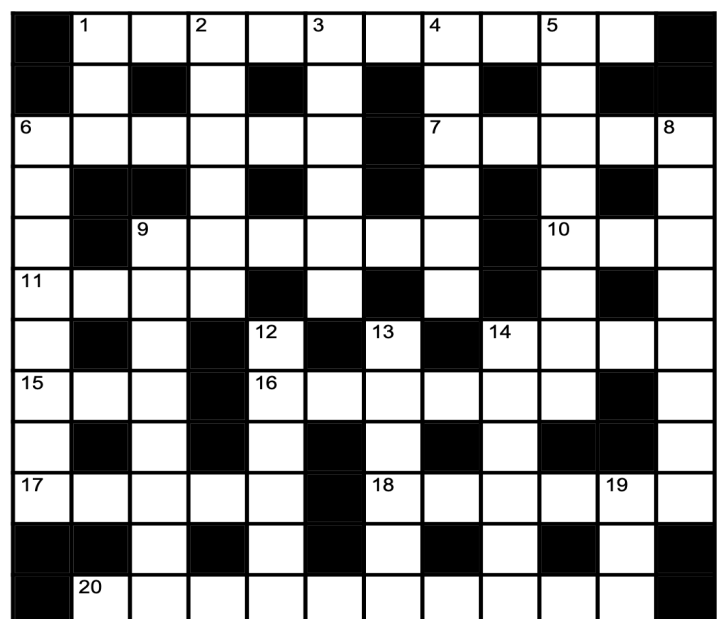
